### RESOLUTION #2022-28

### ADOPTION OF ANNUAL BUDGET FOR CLAY County, South Dakota

Whereas, (7-21-5 thru 13), SDCL provides that the Board of County Commissioners shall each year prepare a Provisional Budget of all contemplated expenditures and revenues of the County and all its institutions and agencies for such fiscal year and, Whereas, the Board of County Commissioners did prepare a Provisional Budget and cause same to be published by law, and Whereas, due and legal notice has been given to the meeting of the Board of County Commissioners for the consideration of such Provisional Budget and all changes, elimination's and additions have been made thereto and,

Whereas, said Provisional Budget was duly adopted as the Annual Budget for 2023 and,

Whereas, at the November 8, 2022 election, the voters of Clay County voted to authorize issuance of bonds in an amount not exceeding \$42.8 million and,

Whereas, the first annual payment will be due for such bond in 2023, NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, That such Annual Budget be amended and all its purposes, schedules, appropriations, amounts, estimates and all matters therein set forth, SHALL BE APPROVED AND ADOPTED AS THE FINAL ANNUAL BUDGET OF THE APPROPRIATION AND EXPENDITURES FOR CLAY County, South Dakota and all its institutions and agencies for calendar year beginning January 1, 2023 and ending December 31, 2023 and the same is hereby approved and adopted by the Board of County Commissioners of Clay County, South Dakota, this 18th day of November, 2022. The Annual Budget so adopted is available for public inspection during normal business hours at the office of the County Auditor, Clay County, South Dakota. The accompanying taxes are levied by Clay County for the year January 1, 2022 through December 31, 2022.
