ORDINANCE NO. #11-02

AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED, Ordinance NO#11-02 "An Ordinance providing for times when on-sale and off-sale alcoholic beverage services are prohibited in Clay County.

SDCL 35-4-81 delegates the authority of city & county governmental to allow the sale, service and consumption of alcoholic beverages on Memorial Day and Sundays and;

Whereas, Clay County desires to regulate the time for selling or serving intoxicating liquor, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CLAY COUNTY, SD:

No on-sale or off-sale licenses, licensed under SDCL 35-4-2 (3). (4), (5), (6), (9), (11), (13), or (18) may sell, serve, or allowed to be consumed on the premises covered by the license, alcoholic beverages between the hours of two a.m. and seven a.m. or any time on Christmas Day.

The sale, service and consumption of alcoholic beverages shall be permitted on Sundays and Memorial Day, except between the hours of two a.m. and seven a.m.

A violation of this section is a Class 2 misdemeanor punishable by thirty (30) days imprisonment in a county jail or a five hundred dollar (\$500.00) fine, or both.
