

January 12, 2016

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session Tuesday January 12, 2016 at 9:00 a.m. Members present: Travis Mockler, Phyllis Packard, Leo Powell, Raymond Passick and Micheal Manning.

Powell moved, seconded by Manning and carried to approve the agenda.

Minutes of the January 5, 2016 meeting were approved with a motion by Manning, seconded by Passick and carried.

Powell moved, seconded by Packard and carried to authorize the Highway Superintendent to use Sanford Health for the random drug/alcohol testing program.

Polley discussed bridge structure #14-110-056 replacement. Passick moved, seconded by Manning and carried to authorize the Chairman to sign required documents for the SD Dept. of Transportation to replace the bridge.

Polley presented a proposal for the 5-year Road & Bridge Plan.

Powell moved, seconded by Packard and carried to declare surplus old iron and aluminum signs.

Polley discussed with the Board having two of the long-time employees take the Class A CDL test to upgrade from Class B. It was the consensus of the Board to allow the expense as ongoing employee training.
