

CLAY / UNION / YANKTON COUNTY 4-H HORSE SHOW 2019

The Clay / Union / Yankton County 4-H Horse Show will be held Wednesday, June 26 at Chuck Donnelly's indoor arena, rural Elk Point. We will be following the same regulations as listed in the 2019 South Dakota 4-H Horse Project Show Guide.

Registration for the County Horse show will be done in Fair Entry. Members can register by going to <http://claysdhorse.fairentry.com>. Fair Entry will open on Saturday, June 1 and close on Wednesday, June 19.

Remember, you must enter a showmanship class at the county level. See #16 on page 7 of the 2019 Show Guide. There is a beginner division for horse showmanship and horse stock/hunt seat on the entry form. The beginner division is for youth ages 8 - 10 (4-H age). Please note: if you participate in beginner western horse showmanship or beginner horse stock seat/hunt seat equitation, you are not eligible to participate in these events in the junior division.

Clay County will have a Grand and Reserve Champion showmanship award in the beginner, junior and senior divisions.

Note: Again in 2019, Clay County 4-H Members who participate at the County Horse Show will automatically be eligible to be considered for "Overall Horse Grand Champion" and "Overall Horse Reserve Champion." This does not result in extra premiums or awards, but there will be a sign displayed in the Exhibit Hall with your picture on it. This "award" is for all age groups competing together based on a point system for each ribbon you earn at the County Horse Show. Purple = 4 points, Blue = 3 points, Red = 2 points, and White = 1 point. These points will be taken from a max of six events, so only 24 points are possible. If you participate in more than six events, we will calculate your points based on the highest ribbons you earned.
