

4-H FASHION REVUE ENTRY FORM 2019

Sewing is FUN! There are lots of fun patterns and fabrics to choose from, and when you sew for yourself, you can make the clothes just how you want them. If you enter the Fashion Revue Contest, you can choose to sew a complete outfit; enter the Sew & Buy category where you sew one part of the outfit such as a skirt or shorts and purchase the top; or you can choose to enter a selected outfit. The objectives of the selected clothing lot are to promote informed consumer selections, learn to co-ordinate garments and accessories and to evaluate fit and quality of ready-to-wear garments. **As in 2018, all age divisions can participate in the State Fair Fashion Revue.** For complete State Fair information, read pages 91 - 92 in the State Fair book.

Participants in Fashion Revue model their sewn or selected outfit for judges who look for certain criteria listed here:

- Poise and posture
- Good personal grooming
- Garment condition – pressed, wrinkled?
- Fit of garment
- Modeling skills
- Accessories used to create a total look
- Pattern appropriate for figure type
- Good fabric and pattern coordination
- Challenging pattern for age or sewing experience
- Quality of construction
- Plan for clothing care – wash, dry clean?




The Fashion Revue registration form is on the following page. **The short pre-registration form below is due in the office by 5 pm on Tuesday, July 9.** The registration form is to be brought the day of the contest (July 17) and given to the judges when you meet with them.

All members who participate in the Fashion Revue Contest will be judged at the county contest on Tuesday, July 17 at the 4-H Center beginning at 9 am. Ribbons will be awarded the day of the contest. Participants in the county contest MUST participate in the public revue on Friday, August 9 at 2 pm during the Clay County Fair.

All participants and parents will be on the Fashion Revue committee to determine theme, stage decorations and finalizing the public revue script. Participants and parents can work together on this the day of the contest.

Outfits should be brought to the 4-H Center the morning of August 8 for display during county fair. The stage will be decorated for the public revue on Friday – all participants are expected to help with the decorating. The public revue is Friday, August 9 – participants should be ready to line-up at 1:45 pm.
