Examples:

Exhibits – Person may exhibit posters or educational displays under the Citizenship, Leadership and Safety projects at the Clay County Fair and Achievement Days.

Public Presentations - Presentations may be given at local 4-H club meetings, local Farm Bureau meetings, school, County and/or State Fair Demonstrations, Illustrated Talks, Project Why and Public Speaking contests.

Community Service Projects – Member may participate by distributing information stickers and brochures, helping with political meetings, etc.

Awards will be presented at the Clay County 4-H Recognition event. Awards will be two Savings Bonds to be presented to one Junior and one Senior 4-H member. Award applications are due at the same time 4-H Record Books and/or Journals are due.
