

ORDINANCE #00-05

**AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT THE KEEPING OF NOISY ANIMALS IN APPROVED,
ORGANIZED SUBDIVISIONS**

BE IT ORDAINED BY CLAY COUNTY, SOUTH DAKOTA:

No person who lawfully keeps an animal in an approved, organized subdivision of the unincorporated portion of Clay County, may allow such animal under his control to make loud noises to the great discomfort of the peace and quiet in such continuous manner as to materially disturb or annoy persons who are of ordinary sensibilities.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED BY CLAY COUNTY, SOUTH DAKOTA:

That any person who acts in violation of this ordinance shall be deemed to have committed a class 2 misdemeanor, the maximum penalty for such being that set forth in SDCL §22-6-2.
