

CLAY COUNTY PARK ORDINANCES # 90-1

Sec. 1 Protection to Trees and Shrubbery

No person shall pick or cut any wild or cultivated flower or cut, break, dig, attempt to remove, or in any way damage any tree, shrub, or plant within the limits of the park.

Sec. 2 Glass Containers

For the safety of the public, it shall be unlawful for any person within any county park to have in his or her possession, custody, or control, any glass bottle or container of any kind. It shall also be unlawful to throw, drop, or dump, deposit, or leave any bottles, glass containers, or broken glass on county park property.

Sec. 3 Fires

It shall be unlawful for any person to build or attempt to build a fire except in such areas and under such regulations as may be designated by the Park Board. No person shall drop, throw, or otherwise scatter lighted matches, burnt cigarettes, or cigars, or other inflammable material within any park area or on any highway, road, or street abutting or contiguous thereto.

Sec. 4 Camping

It shall be unlawful for any person to set up tents, shelters, or other temporary shelter for the purpose of overnight camping, nor shall any person leave in any county park at closing hours any movable structure or special vehicle tent used, or which could be used, for such purpose, such as horse-trailer, camping trailer, motor home, or the like.

Sec. 5 Motorized Vehicles

It shall be unlawful to drive, operate, or park any automobile or other licensed motorized vehicle except on an established street, driveway, or parking lot in any county park; or to leave or park any such vehicle in any place other than one established for public parking.

Sec. 6 Animals Protected

It shall be unlawful for any person to rob, injure, or destroy any bird nests within the limits of any county park. It shall also be unlawful to hunt, molest, harm, capture, or kill any bird or other wild creature within any county park.


Sec. 7 Hours of Operation

The county parks shall be open daily to the public during the hours of 6:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. during the months of May through September, and during the hours of 6:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. during the months of October through April; Out of concern for the public safety, as well as the concern for the safety of the individual, it shall be unlawful for any person or persons other than county personnel conducting county business therein to occupy or be present in such parks during any other hours.

Any section or part of a park, or an entire park, may be declared closed to the public by the Park Board at any time and for any interval of time, either temporarily or at regular or stated intervals.


NOTICE OF ADOPTION

Notice is hereby given that Ordinance No. 90-1 establishing zoning regulations for Clay County, South Dakota, providing restrictions, district boundaries and zoning map, and providing for repeal of all ordinances or parts thereof in conflict therewith, was duly adopted by the County Board of Commissioners on the 16th day of January, 1990, and will become effective on FEBRUARY 15 1990, unless the referendum shall be invoked.
