

ORDINANCE # 96-1

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSION OF CLAY COUNTY, SOUTH DAKOTA:

That this Ordinance establishes speed limits pursuant to South Dakota Codified Law (SDCL) 32-25-9.1; and that the maximum speed limit on the Clay County Highway system or Township roads be established at 55 miles per hour or as otherwise specifically posted; and that any alteration or modification of the speed limit on any Clay County Highway or Township roads referred to by this ordinance shall take effect only after an approved Commission action in respect to any such modification or alteration of the speed limit. The fines for the violation of the provisions of this ordinance shall be the same as set forth in the "Fine and Bond Schedule" set by the Presiding Circuit Court Judge for the First Judicial Circuit which at the time of the adoption of this ordinance are as follows:


