

DILLON-JOLLEY SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Award: A scholarship to attend Teen Leadership Conference for Clay County 4-H youth between the ages of 14 and 18.

Teen Leadership Conference registration fee will be paid from interest earned on the Dillon Estate Trust Fund and supplemented by the Clay County 4-H Leaders Association.

The scholarship is awarded to one boy and one girl at 4-H Recognition Event. Recipients would be eligible to use the award the following summer. If recipient is unable to attend, the award would be shifted to a selected alternate.

Applications are due at the same time 4-H Record Books or Journals are due.

4-H MEMBER REQUIREMENTS

- Must be 14 years of age by January 1 of the year attending conference.
- Must meet the basic requirements for a Member Participation Certificate in year applying.
- Must submit Scholarship Application.
- Must submit an up-to-date 4-H Record Book or Journal.
- Must be enrolled in 4-H club work the year attending scholarship.
- Must have parent or guardian permission.
- If circumstances prevent recipient from attending, recipient will notify the Clay County Extension Office as soon as possible so alternate may be notified.
- This award may only be received once during 4-H enrollment.
